

Greenwood Christian Academy (GCA) decided to forgo its traditional school fundraisers this year for something for service oriented. On November 21, student body, nearly 600 children aged 5 to 18, came together and packed over 10,000 meals for the Refuge in Greenwood and food pantries in Harlan County, Kentucky.
