**INDIANA MEMBERS FOUNDATION ACCEPTING APPLICATIONS FOR
ROBERT E MARTIN COLLEGIATE SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM**

(Indianapolis, IN, January, 2018) Indiana Members Foundation, the charitable arm of Indiana Members Credit Union (IMCU), along with Indiana Members Credit Union, announces it is accepting applications for the Robert E. Martin Collegiate Scholarship Program available to college students that are members of Indiana Members Credit Union. In 2017, Indiana Members Foundation awarded \$25,000 through the Robert E. Martin Collegiate Scholarship Program and has increased the amount awarded to \$50,000 for 2018. The \$50,000 will be dispersed as ten (10) \$5,000 collegiate scholarships through the Robert E. Martin Collegiate Scholarship Program. Applications will be accepted annually from January 1 through March 31.

The Robert E. Martin Collegiate Scholarship Program was established to honor Robert E. Martin for his 42 years of dedication and service as a board member of IMCU as well as his commitment to education throughout his career as Vice Chancellor for Administration and Finance at Indiana University-Purdue University at Indianapolis (IUPUI).
